COUNSELING DEPARTMENT:

- **Students have TWO WEEKS from the first day of school to request to change a class** to a different class (e.g. Film as Literature to Creative Writing) or a different level (e.g. Biology to Honors Biology). After the first two weeks of school, students will NOT be able to change classes as there will be too much curriculum missed in the new course. Changes can be made on a space available basis and requests may not always be possible. **School-initiated changes related to class placements or class withdrawals will be made at the discretion of the principal or his/her designee.** Class/course changes must be academic in nature. Changes to accommodate a student because they do not like an instructor or cannot get up early are not acceptable reasons to change a class/course.

COLLEGE OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM:

- **Santa Ana College** classes for the **Fall 2026** semester begin **August 17th, 2026 through December 5th, 2026 (8/17/26-12/05/26)**. An accelerated college course is an intensive, fast-paced class that condenses traditional 15- to 16-week semester material into a shorter window, typically lasting 5 to 8 weeks. Students cover the same academic content and earn the same number of credits in a fraction of the time. Accelerated courses range from **8/17/26-10/11/26 & 10/12/17-12/05/26**.

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- **BREAKFAST & LUNCH:** All meals this year are FREE, so every student has the option for both breakfast and lunch. We ask that no food deliveries be made at school by outside restaurants or delivery services, as everyone has the option to eat for free on campus.
- **FREE YOUTH OCTA BUS PASSES:** Beginning this school year, OCTA will no longer provide Wave cards directly to school districts. To ensure your child can continue riding OCTA buses **free of charge**, parents and guardians must renew their child's Youth Ride Free pass by **September 30, 2026**. To renew, please:
 - Create a **Wave account**.
 - Submit a new **Youth Ride Free application**.
 - Once approved, the new pass will be loaded onto your child's **existing Wave card**—no replacement card is needed.
 - **Don't have a Wave card?** No problem! You can request one as part of the application process, and the card will be mailed directly to you.
 - Please visit OCBus.com/Apply to create your account and complete the application.
 - We encourage families to complete this process before the September 30 deadline to avoid any interruption in your child's free bus transportation.



- **PARKING PERMITS:** Students who drive vehicles to school must complete paperwork to receive clearance to park in the school parking structure. Only students who have submitted all required documents to the front office can be provided with a parking permit.
- **AERIES PORTAL:** The [Aeries Parent/Student Portal](#) provides parents and students with a secure, convenient way to access student information such as attendance, grades, and assignments.
