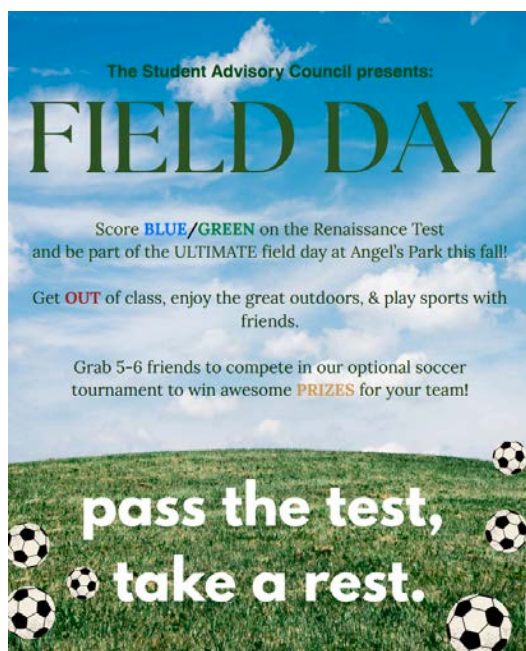

- Keep track of your usernames, passwords, application IDs, and deadlines.
- Ask for help early! Please do not wait until the day an application is due.

COLLEGE OPPORTUNITY PROGRAM:

- **Santa Ana College** classes for the **Fall 2026** semester begin **August 17th, 2026 through December 5th, 2026 (8/17/26-12/05/26)**. An accelerated college course is an intensive, fast-paced class that condenses traditional 15- to 16-week semester material into a shorter window, typically lasting 5 to 8 weeks. Students cover the same academic content and earn the same number of credits in a fraction of the time. Accelerated courses range from **8/17/26-10/11/26 & 10/12/17-12/05/26**.

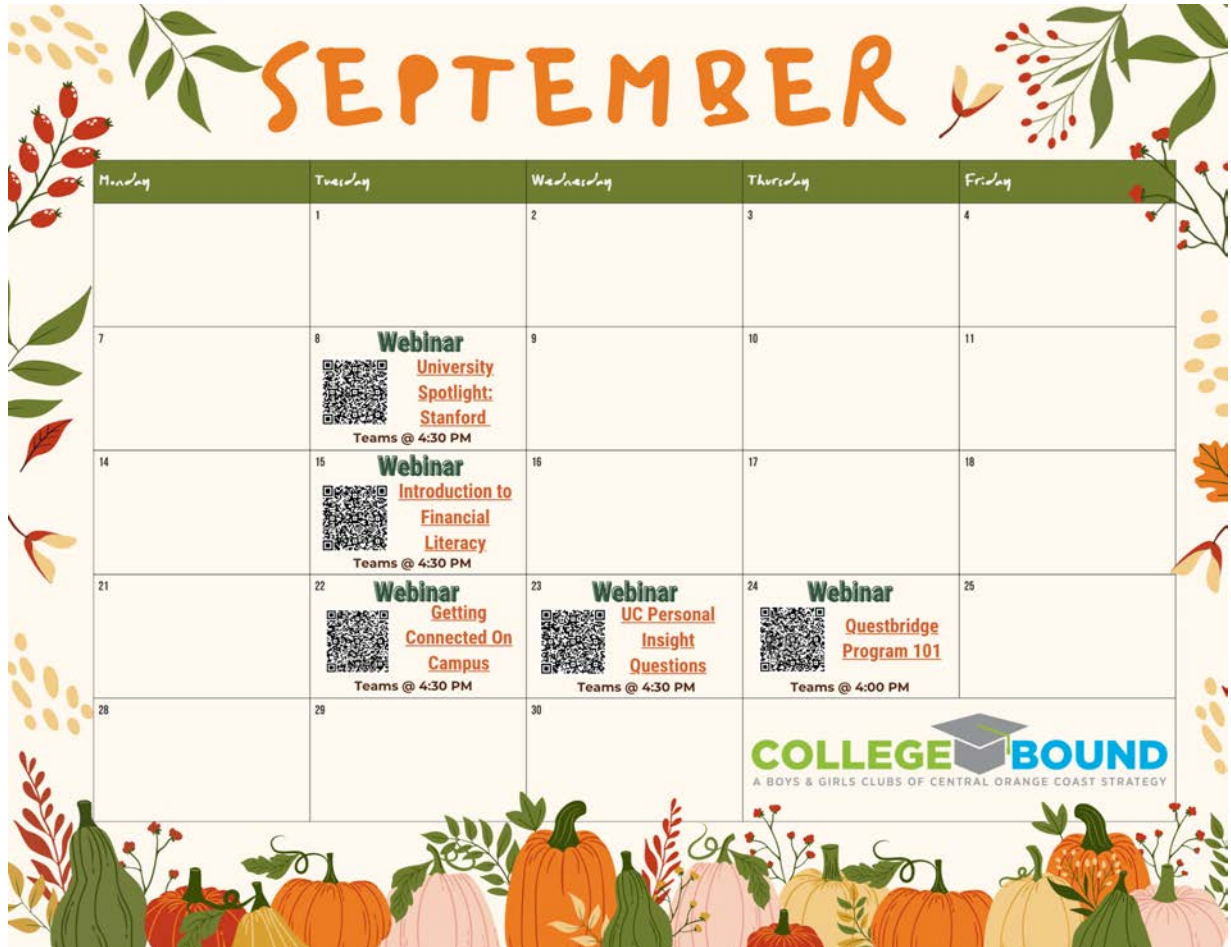

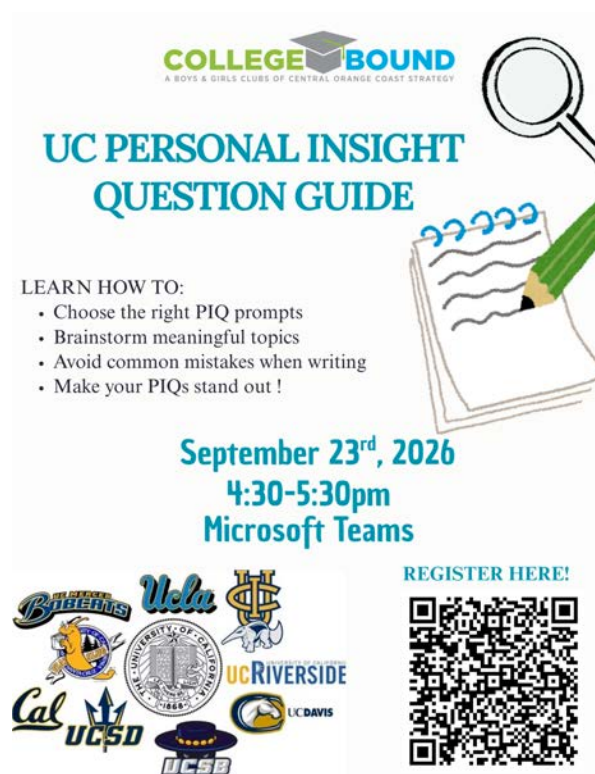

- **BREAKFAST & LUNCH:** All meals this year are FREE, so every student has the option for both breakfast and lunch. We ask that no food deliveries be made at school by outside restaurants or delivery services, as everyone has the option to eat for free on campus.
- **OC Streetcar** testing is becoming more frequent and routine along the full route between the Santa Ana Train Station and the Harbor/Westminster stop in Garden Grove. As testing increases, streetcar activity will become more noticeable throughout the community, including horn and bell sounds, as preparations continue for passenger service early next year.
 - As testing increases, sharing the road safely with streetcars is especially important. Please stay alert, obey traffic laws, park legally and keep streetcar tracks and travel lanes clear. Illuminated signs at certain intersections will activate as streetcars approach to temporarily detour traffic. Vehicles that block or interfere with streetcar operations may be subject to towing in accordance with local parking regulations.
 - **What You Can Expect:**
 - Testing taking place more frequently, including nights and weekends
 - Streetcars operating routinely at posted speed limits
 - Streetcars stopping at station platforms, with doors opening and closing as part of testing
 - Bells sound as streetcars approach, arrive at, depart from or pass through station platforms; use may vary as testing continues.
 - Both horns and bells sound as streetcars pass through certain station platforms, approach crossings or when needed for safety; use may vary as testing continues.

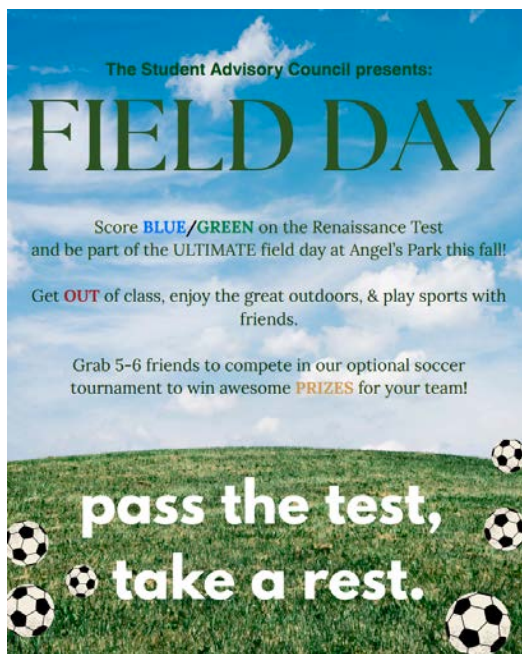

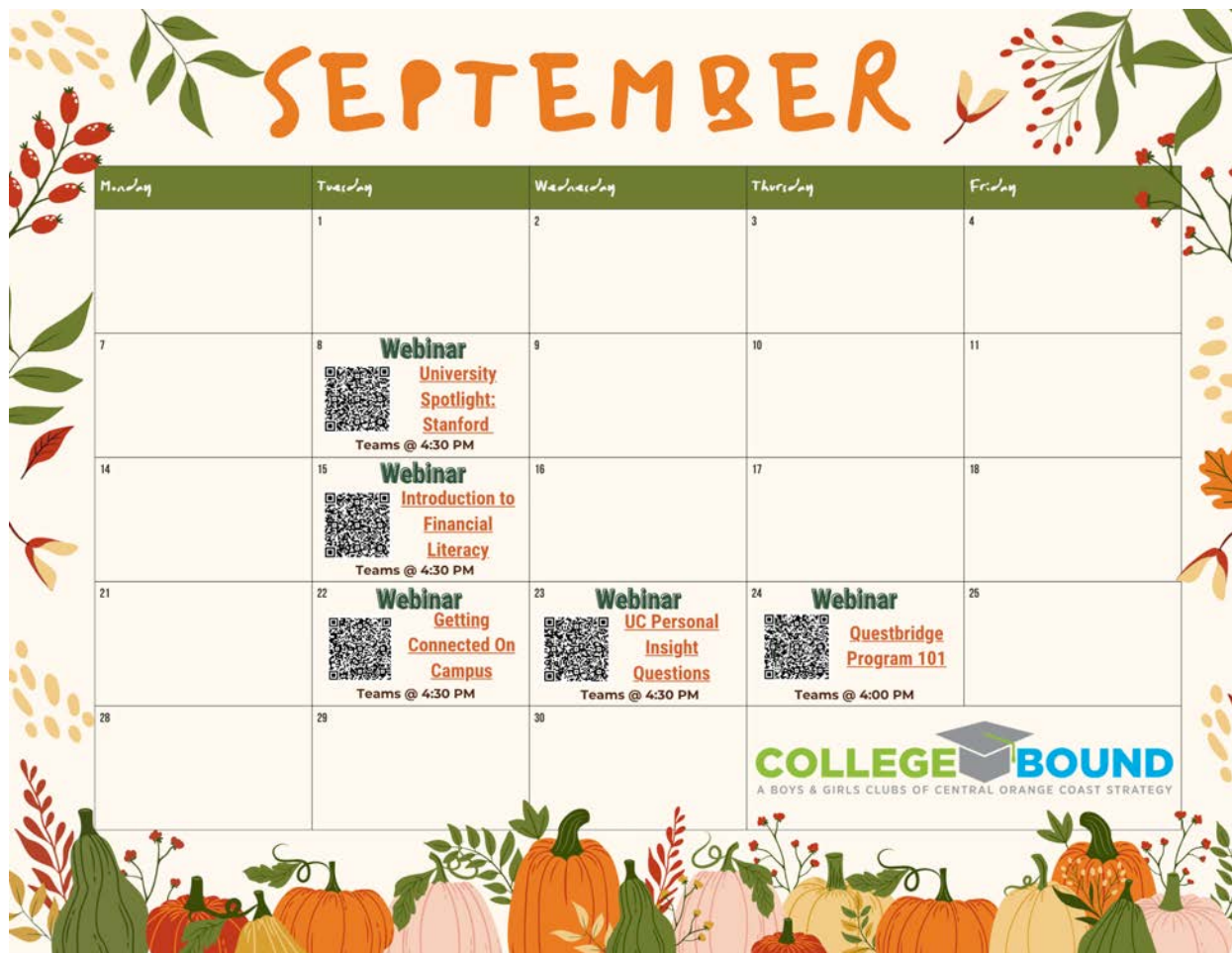

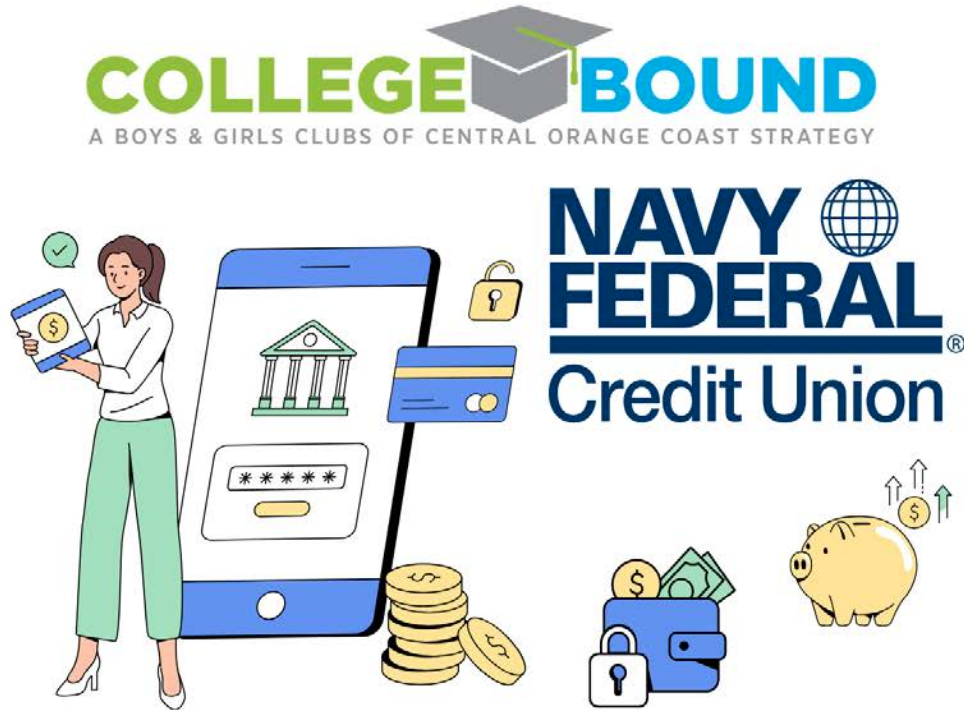
