### SANTA ANA CAMPUS PUBLIC INPUT AND LOCAL CONTROL ACCOUNTABILITY PLAN (LCAP)

Mark Cruickshank, Assistant Principal, presented the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) for the Santa Ana campus. He updated the Board on the California School Dashboard. There was an improvement in the suspension rate and the school is now in the Green category for all student groups. The school took several actions to improve CAASPP scores, including offering more AP and Honors courses, Rosetta Stone software for ELD classes, professional development on instructional strategies, and the implementation of a new reading program called Reading Plus. Additionally, NOVA sponsors the PSAT for 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, and 11<sup>th</sup> graders. Parental involvement increased substantially from the previous year. The overall satisfaction rate is 83%, with 88% of respondents reporting they are satisfied with campus safety.

### COACHELLA CAMPUS PUBLIC INPUT AND LOCAL CONTROL ACCOUNTABILITY PLAN (LCAP)

Adrienne Haggerty, Teacher, presented the Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP) for the Coachella campus. To improve CAASPP scores, the school implemented several academic campaigns and provided workshops on test taking strategies on three separate Saturdays. The school also received support from Riverside County for ELD students. To improve school satisfaction, the Coachella campus will host a student focus group and a parent LCAP meeting to discuss parent feedback. The overall school satisfaction rate is 91% with 90% of parents and students reporting they are satisfied with campus safety. The school exceeded its goal to increase dual eligibility with 50.5% of all students eligible to participate in college courses in 2018-2019. The school also exceeded its goal of meeting most parents' satisfaction on parent events. Ninety percent of parents who attended parent events reported they found the information to be useful.

### FINANCIAL UPDATE

Karen Lester, Board Treasurer, presented the financial update for the Coachella and Santa Ana campuses. Coachella is in a good, stable position with enrollment and revenue closely aligned with the Second Interim Budget. For Santa Ana, enrollment and revenue are also closely aligned with the Second Interim Budget. Santa Ana's budget is on track and the school is meeting the bond ratio covenant.

### SCHOOL FOOD PROGRAM CONTRACTS

John Bowen, Director of Human Resources & Operations, presented the Preferred Meals food program contract for NOVA Academy-Santa Ana. He reported that the school is in its second year with Preferred Meals and there have been very few issues. There is good participation in the food program. For 2019-

2020, there will be a cost reduction from last year's contract. The food program contract for the Coachella campus will be presented at the next Board Meeting on May 23, 2019.
