 - FAFSA: The Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) is a free form that students use to apply for federal financial aid for college or career school: grants, work-study, and loans.
 - The FAFSA is the most important step in applying for federal aid. Colleges use FAFSA data to determine a student's eligibility for federal aid, and many states and colleges also use it to award their own aid. Some private aid providers may also use FAFSA information to determine eligibility.
 - To complete the FAFSA, students provide information about themselves and their parents, including income, assets, and investments. They may also need to provide general information like names, addresses, and driver's licenses. After submitting the FAFSA, students receive a Student Aid Report (SAR) that details their eligible aid and Expected Family Contribution.
 - Students must complete the FAFSA each year, as their financial aid award amount may change based on their financial status.
 - Parents of seniors can start preparing to apply for financial aid by collecting the following:

- A copy of their 2024 Federal Tax Return
- A copy of their 2024 W-2s
- Social Security/ITIN numbers of parents and students (if applicable)
- Important Dates for parents and students:
 - Dates of Marriage, Dates of Divorce, Dates of Death and Birthdates
 - **CADAA:** The CADAA is a free application that takes about an hour to complete. The information provided on the CADAA is used to calculate a student's Student Aid Index (SAI), which is used to determine eligibility for financial aid.
- The CADAA is an option for FAFSA-eligible students who are having trouble completing the FAFSA because they have a contributor without a Social Security number.
